This commitment is elegantly symbolized in our 43rd National Conference logo, which draws inspiration from the Indigenous Wound, Ostomy, and Continence logo, thoughtfully designed by Thomas H. Anderson.



The logo is an intricate fusion of symbolism and history. The image of a wheat stem adorning a cowboy hat pays homage to the profound heritage of Indigenous farming in the Prairies. The White Cowboy hat, emblematic of Calgary's "western hospitality," welcomes visitors to the city while simultaneously evoking memories of the celebrated Calgary Stampede. This annual event, held since 1918, is a dynamic convergence of cowboys, fairgoers, and First Nations, rooted in the century-old legacy of First Nations Treaty 7. The Stampede holds a special place as a safe haven for First Nations people to honor their culture and traditions.

Furthermore, it is worth noting that elements integral to Prairie Indigenous culture, such as Bolo Ties, Cowboy Hats, Cowboy Boots, and turquoise jewelry, have significantly influenced and shaped these iconic symbols.

2023 National Conference (Ottawa, Ontario) Demographics

We are thrilled to share that with the support of our Honoured Corporate Partners, Corporate Partners, Corporate Supporters, and Conference Exhibitors from last year, we were able to hold our **largest National Wound**, **Ostomy and Continence Conference ever**, bringing in 562 registrants from across Canada and internationally.

Of the 562, we were joined by 264 NSWOCC Members, and 123 Non-Member Health Care Professionals and Patients. The rest of the numbers are represented by Industry Members/Exhibitor Representatives (141), and guests of registrants for the networking event and/or Banquet and WOC Institute Graduation Ceremony (34).

Out of the general delegates— NSWOCC Members and Non-Member Non-Member Health Care Professionals and Patients (excluding Industry and plus-one guests)—the majority were from Ontario (55%), with Québec being the next highest reported province at 12.4%.

Amongst NSWOCC Members, the majority of registrants were NSWOCs (169 total), with NSWOC (WOC-EP) Students (34 total) and Skin Wellness Associate Nurses (22 total) coming in next as the most popular registration types. Amongst Non-Members, the top types were RNs (49 total), RPN/LPNs (16 total), Physicians (8 total), and Nurse Practitioners (7).
